

Outstanding Social Studies Supervisor Award

The Georgia Outstanding Supervisor Award shall be given to a social studies leader who best exemplifies the leadership role as described in the NSSSA Position Statement on the *Role of the Social Studies Supervisor*. The nominee need not hold a supervisory title, but should demonstrate the delineated leadership qualities.

Article III - Membership shall be open to members of the National Council for the Social Studies who have supervisory responsibilities for the social studies curriculum and instructional program pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12. This would include individuals with such titles as director, department head or chairperson, curriculum coordinator, consultant, supervisor, specialist, assistant principal and others in leadership roles.

Nomination Materials

- Contact and affiliation information for nominee and nominator (next page).
- Description of the position held by the nominee.
- Description of 250 words or less explaining why the candidate is being nominated.
- Vita on nominee: education, positions held, professional memberships, and activities.
- Support materials (up to 5 pages) which may include letters of support from others (administrators, professional acquaintances, students, parents, etc.), newspaper articles, and miscellaneous information which will help us to know the nominee better.
